The Excellence Scholarship What is Horizon?

The International Relations Department (DRI) at the University of La Réunion offers Horizon Excellence Scholarships (BEH) from its own resources to study in one of the program's Master 2 courses and obtain a Master's degree from the University of La Réunion, a degree of excellence recognized in France, Europe, and internationally.

This program, which is fully in line with the University of La Réunion's regional cooperation strategy, is aimed at students from 16 partner countries in the Indian Ocean region, and more specifically at students who wish to pursue doctoral studies, if possible under joint supervision at the University of La Réunion.

Program objective:

- > To promote and raise awareness of the University of La Réunion in the region and internationally as the largest French and European institution on the Africa-Asia axis.
- > To offer high-quality training to student candidates.
- > Offering students from partner countries in the program an opportunity to study abroad
- > Train doctoral students for the University of Réunion and for the program's partner countries in order to increase their teaching staff, with the possibility of joint supervision.

Who can apply?

- > Students currently enrolled in a Master's 1 program at a higher education institution located in one of the program's partner countries;
- > Holders of a Master's 1 or Master's 2 degree obtained at a higher education institution located in one of the program's partner countries.
- > Candidates who wish to enroll in a Master's 2 program at the University of La Réunion, with the prospect, subject to selection conditions, of continuing on to a PhD program, under joint supervision or co-supervision of their thesis with their home university.

Applicants cannot already be students or graduates of the University of La Réunion or any other French university at the time of application. Students must demonstrate a minimum level of B2 in French at the time of application.

SELECTION

The selection process consists of two stages:

1. Selection of the candidate by the teaching committee of the M2 program to which he/she is applying
2. Among eligible candidates from partner countries in the Indian Ocean region who are supported by the M2 teaching committees, the BEH Committee of the International Relations Department selects the best profiles for the award of Horizon Excellence Scholarships.

> Criteria:

- Decision and support by the selection committee for the requested Master'2 program
- Academic excellence
- Motivation
- Relevance and suitability of the project to the course of study
- Level of French (minimum certified level B2)

Only candidates who have been selected for Master 2 are ranked on the main list and the supplementary list. Candidates who are not admitted to Master 2 are therefore not eligible for the scholarship. Those who are selected for Master 2 are informed by email by the International Relations Department of their ranking or of the rejection of their scholarship application following the selection committee's decision.

Selected candidates must confirm their participation within seven days of being notified of their selection. They must also provide proof of having obtained their Master's 1 degree from their home institution, if this document was not provided at the time of application. It is therefore essential that they check their email regularly, including their spam or junk mail folders. Once their participation has been confirmed, successful candidates must immediately begin the visa application process and complete their administrative registration at the University of La Réunion.

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT AND WHAT IT COVERS:

A maximum of €710 per month for 10 months (August 2026-May 2027)

Unless otherwise agreed with the French embassies in the program partner countries, with this scholarship the student will have to pay:

- > Airfare
- > University registration and CVEC
- > Accommodation
- > Other daily expenses (clothing, food, books, outings, etc.).

COUNTRIES WITH THE STUDY IN FRANCE (CEF) PROCEDURE

DECEMBER 2025-JANUARY 2026

Deadline for submitting applications to Campus France offices. **Applicants are invited to contact their local office for the exact date. They** must specify in their application that they are applying for the Horizon Excellence Scholarship program (in their cover letter). On the Études en France platform, in the "Special status" and "Other cases" section, they must select "Candidate for a scholarship call."

MARCH 15, 2026

Deadline for interviews and review of applications by Campus France offices

APRIL 30, 2026

Deadline for selection of Master 2 candidates by the teaching committees.

COUNTRIES WITHOUT THE STUDY IN FRANCE (CEF)

Provisional admission dates: **February 25 to March 23, 2026**

AUGUST 2026

Arrival of successful candidates at the University of La Réunion.

INSCRIPTION AU PROGRAMME
"HORIZON EXCELLENCE SCHOLARSHIP"

PURSUE A DOCTORATE:

Doctoral studies are not guaranteed for BEH scholarship recipients. Students may pursue doctoral studies if:

- > They successfully complete their Master's 2 degree.
- > He/she is authorized by the relevant doctoral school
- > Has he/she found a thesis supervisor?
- > He/she finds funding (Region, CIFRE, etc.)

Having completed a Master's 2 degree at the University of Réunion increases a candidate's chances of continuing on to a PhD.

If pursuing a PhD, the ideal situation is for the PhD to be carried out in partnership with an accredited teacher-researcher from the candidate's home university.

DROPOUT

In the event of withdrawal from studies, except in cases of force majeure, students must notify the academic supervisor of their master's program and the head of the excellence scholarship program at the DRI at least one month before withdrawal.

In cases of abandonment of their studies, the commission of international relations will decide whether or not the student must reimburse the amount of scholarships paid since their arrival.
